EXPLORE

- 1 What lesson from Sunday's sermon most impacted you?
- 2 Have you ever known someone who had a distorted view of themselves: too high, too low, too attached, too detached, etc.? What was that like for you to observe?
- 3 Shechem had a view of himself and others that was distorted and wrong. How so?
- 4 Sexual sin causes damage to the victim, to the perpetrator, and to those connected to them. What are some of the effects? Why is the belief that "what we do with our bodies affects no one else" so patently false?
- 5 In what ways is the request and invitation of Hamor quite reasonable? (Does your opinion change depending on whether or not he knew what his son had done? If so, how?) In what ways is Hamor's proposition dangerous for Jacob and his family?
- 6 Dinah's brothers laid a trap for Shechem, Hamor, and the men of the area in order to get revenge. How do you feel about the revenge that was exacted? Do you think it was appropriate?
- 7 God is never mentioned in this passage. Where or how do we see His hand? Why do you think this story is included in Genesis?

PRAY

Pray that the Lord would help you to see those who are hurting around you and that you would grow in your compassion for them.
