EXPLORE

- 1 Read Romans 8:1-8. What highlights from the passage and the sermon resonate with you?
- 2 Have you ever felt the weight of condemnation or captivity? Describe that feeling.
- 3 Romans 8:1,2 indicate that believers in Jesus are no longer condemned but rather free from the law of sin and death. To what extent does this describe the reality of your life? Where do you find yourself prone to live as a condemned prisoner?
- 4 How does God make righteousness available (8:3,4a)? How does this truth inspire you to awe, wonder, and worship?
- 5 What does/should life look like under the mastery of the Spirit versus life under the mastery of sin (8:4b)?
- 6 What do your desires reveal about what your mind is set on(8:5-8)? How have you experienced "life" and "peace" only attributable to the Spirit (8:6)? Where do you need a change in perspective this week?
- 7 Read Romans 12:1,2, Ephesians 4:20-24, and 2 Corinthians 5:14-21. What additional insights jump out at you related to our study?

Pray that you will submit the control of your heart and mind to the Spirit of God in increasing and necessary ways.
