## Assessing the Content of Paul's Address



### Paul showed familiarity with what his hearers believed.



"Paul knows his own message and the mentality of the people he evangelizes. Too many Christians know their own message but understand far too little about how and why others think as they do." DARRELL BOCK



"We cannot expect unbelievers to learn our ideas first so that they can understand us. We need to go to them, learn what they think, and find ways to present them with the truths of the Gospel in ways that will be meaningful to them." PAUL COPAN
