


Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.

Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.








Too often we are willing to do everything to keep our kids physically safe and healthy... but almost nothing to keep them spiritually safe and healthy.

If you are not resting as a parent in your identity in Christ, you will look for identity in your children.




As a parent you're not dealing just with bad behavior, but a condition that causes it.

Teaching and modeling the protective beauty of authority is one of the foundations of good parenting. Only God's grace has the power to rescue fools.




You are parenting a worshiper, so it's important to remember that what rules your child's heart will control his behavior.

The goal of parenting is not control of behavior, but rather heart and life change.








