Yahweh vs. Amun



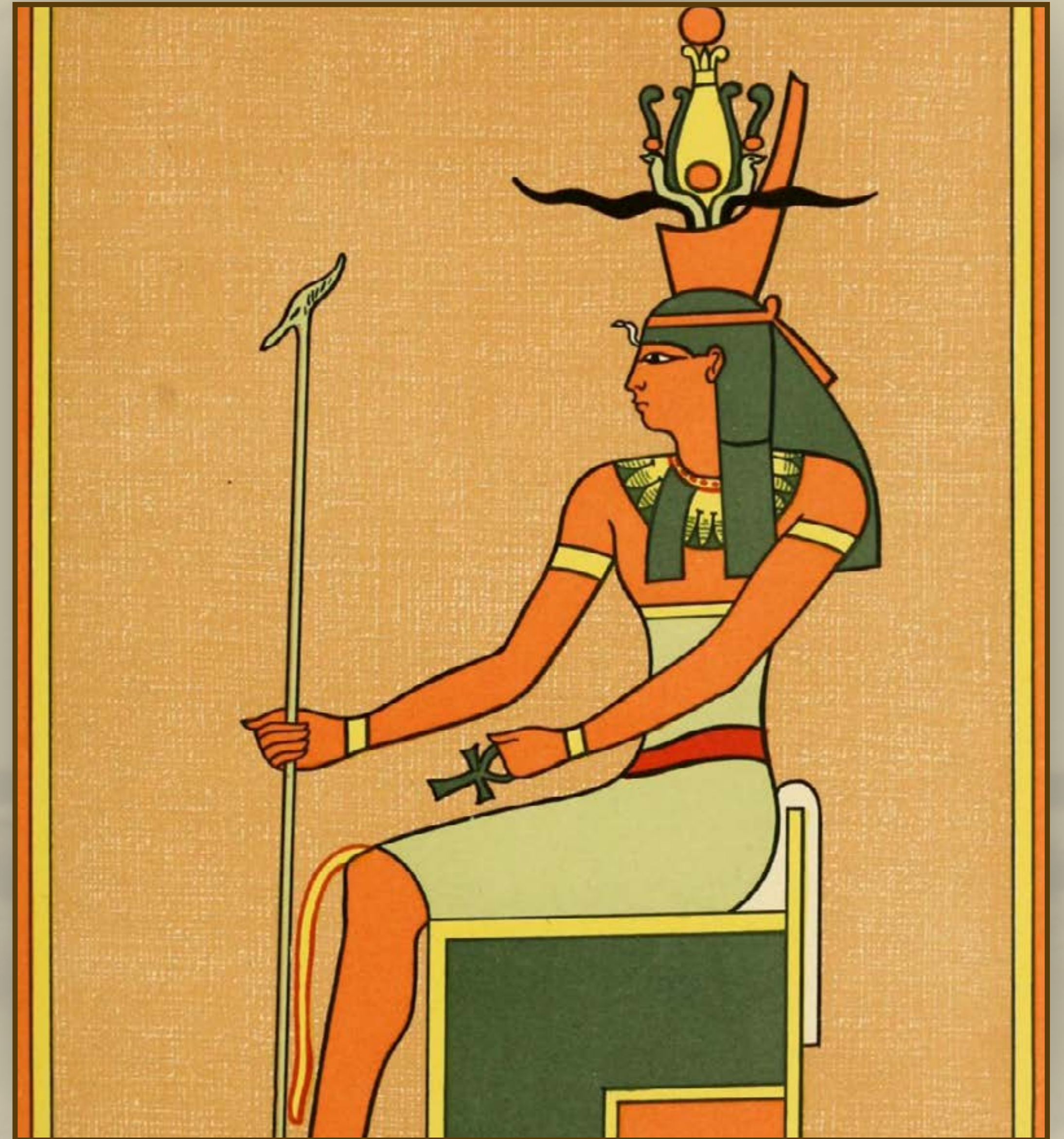

and the frogs came up and covered the land of Egypt.*

*Then the Lord said to Moses, “Say to Aaron, ‘Stretch out your staff and strike the dust of the earth, so **that it may become gnats** in all the land of Egypt.’”*

Yahweh vs. Mnevis



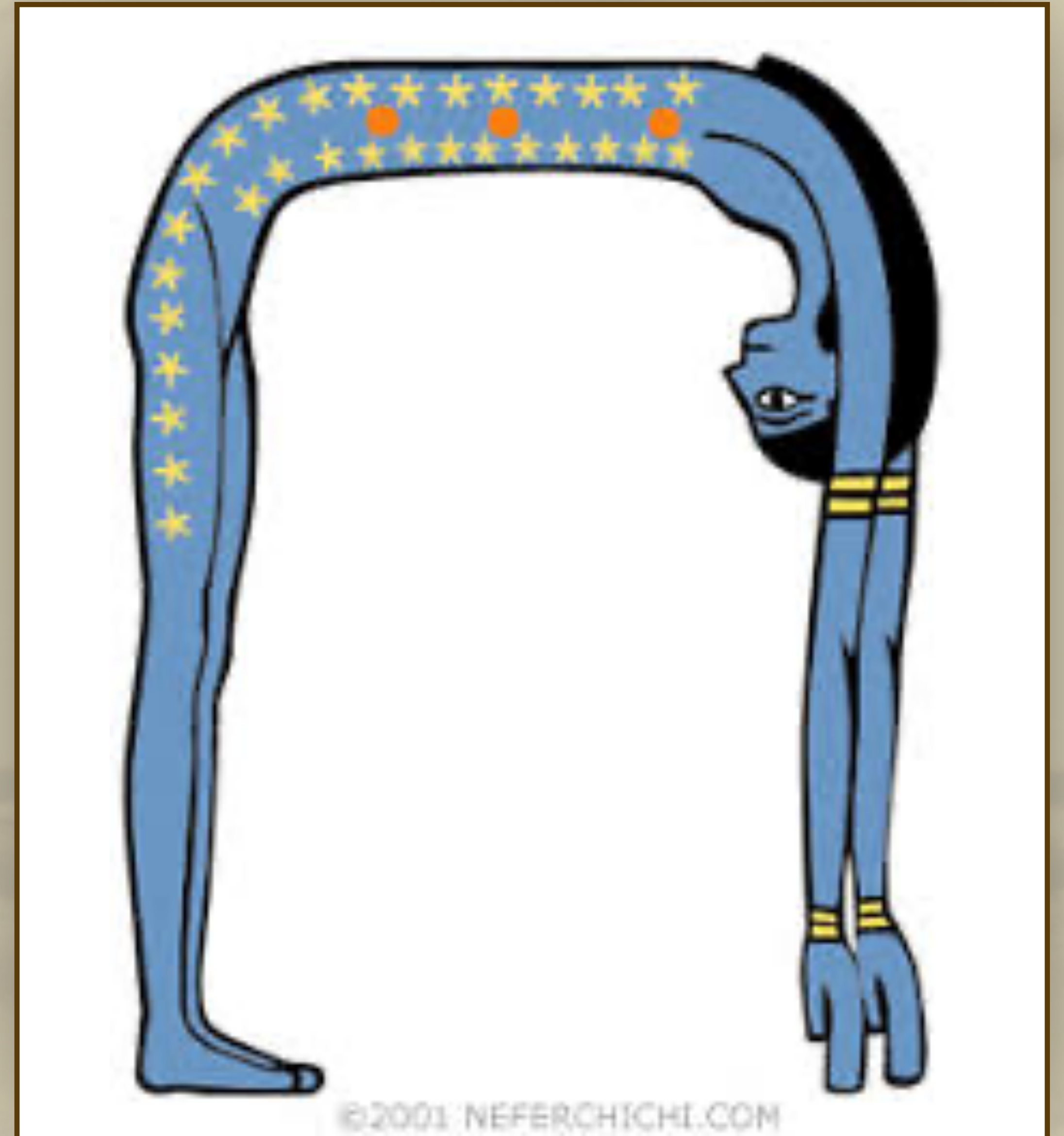
*And the next day the Lord did this thing. **All the livestock of the Egyptians died, but not one of the livestock of the people of Israel died.***

Yahweh vs. Nut



*Then Moses stretched out his staff toward heaven, and the Lord sent thunder and **hail**, and fire ran down to the earth. And the Lord rained hail upon the land of Egypt.*

*So Moses stretched out his staff over the land of Egypt, and the Lord brought an east wind upon the land all that day and all that night. When it was morning, the east wind had brought **the locusts.***

*So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was pitch **darkness** in all the land of Egypt three days.*

Day	Creation	Plague
4	Sun, Moon, & Stars	Darkness
5	Birds & Fish	Death of Fish
6	Land Animals & Humans	Death of Livestock & Death of the Firstborn
