Our Always Good God

Goodness is the benevolent kindness that characterizes God and His way.

God, who alone is good (Mark 10:17,18), is good in Himself (Psalm 34:8) and all He does (119:68). As the good God, He is the source of all good things (James 1:17; Psalm 84:11).

And the LORD said to Moses, "This very thing that you have spoken I will do, for you have found favor in My sight, and I know you by name."
