## **EXPLORE**

- 1 The Declaration of Independence states: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights..." On what basis did those early leaders make that claim? On what basis do you believe it?
- 2 How is our society doing in living out the "equality of all men" before God? Explain. Who are some individuals or groups to whom you might be tempted to show favoritism or to treat as inferior? Why them?
- 3 James focuses on the division of rich and poor. What are some other divisions among people that society or churches might wrongly foster?
- 4 Why is favoritism in the Church of Jesus Christ such a contradiction? In what ways is it possible to affirm the equal value of all believers and yet wrongly treat some as inferior or less valuable?
- 5 What is Grace Polaris Church doing to affirm and practically highlight the "equality of all men" before God? Think of examples in a variety of categories.
- 6 We are inclined to excuse our favoritism (whether conscious or not) on the basis of all the other things we are doing well before God. How do verses 8–11 speak to that?
- 7 God is marked by mercy and compassion. Followers of Jesus Christ should be, too. What person or group ought to receive more affirmation and compassion from you?
