- 4 We speak of being "self-actualized," "true to ourselves," and "authentic." What's the danger of those pursuits according to 3:14–16? What does 3:16 say about human nature and the goodness of sinful, fallen people?
- 5 Why does James put such an emphasis on the reality of peace when he speaks of wisdom?
- 6 What are one or two traits from 3:17,18 which may be lacking in your life? Explain.
- 7 Though James doesn't mention the Holy Spirit in this passage, what role does He play in living a life of wisdom?
