### **EXPLORE**

- 1 James speaks in very direct language, especially in chapters 4–5. Have you ever had a believer who loved you speak directly to you, even to the point of admonishment? How did you receive it?
- 2 What are some reasons believers give to describe or explain why they're in conflict with other believers? What personal motivations are they often blind to in such conflicts?
- 3 James exposes the temptation we face to be driven by our pleasures ("hedonism"). What are the pleasures that might possibly undermine or distort your allegiance to Christ (4:3)?
- 4 What's the difference between friendship with (or loving) the world and being friends with (or loving) people of this world?
- 5 Practically speaking, what does it mean to submit yourself to God? What does it mean to resist the devil?
- 6 Grace not only gets us in (salvation) but leads us on (sanctification). How is the promise of God's grace a great encouragement to those who are already believers? Read and consider Hebrews 4:15,16 and Titus 2:11–14.
- 7 God's grace seems to be conditioned upon humility for those who come to Him. Why? What does Luke 18:9–14 reveal about this humility?
