EXPLORE

- 4 Describe a situation in your life (past or present) in which you strove together with others toward a common goal. How effective was your teamwork, and what lessons can you apply to the Gospel calling of believers (1:27c)?
- 5 Why is teamwork more difficult when certain team members are absent or not contributing? How is that true in our spiritual calling to "strive together as one?"
- 6 Who actively opposes believers in our day for their faith in Christ and in what ways? For what should we face opposition (1:28)?
- 7 The Bible says that it is a gift of God's grace that we are called to suffer (1:29). How do you make sense of that? How can we learn or choose to suffer well? What are some benefits of suffering, specifically as followers of Christ?
