EXPLORE

- 1 Why does Paul list four different descriptions of commonality among believers (2:1) when one could have sufficed? What is he attempting to demonstrate?
- 2 Paul appeals to the Philippians to "make [his] joy complete," but we might have expected something like "because it's reasonable with others" or "it's right before God." Why does Paul make his plea so personal?
- 3 What's the difference between unity and uniformity? Which one is Paul calling believers to in 2:3? Explain.
- 4 Why is "selfish ambition" and "vain conceit" so poisonous to unity? How might they be displayed between believers who belong to the same spiritual family/church? How might you be tempted?
- 5 Why should humility be the default perspective/attitude for every Christian (2:3)? What fuels real humility?
- 6 Does 2:4 require a believer to be a doormat for the wishes and desires of everyone else? If not, what does it require?
- 7 What might you need to do to foster practical unity with other believers, including those in our church? What issues are most difficult for you to overlook regarding differences you have with other believers?
