EXPLORE

- 1 We see the Trinity spotlighted in this passage, especially in 3:21,22. How would you briefly explain that biblical teaching on the Trinity to a friend?
- 2 What is the purpose of the genealogy Luke recorded? What is significant about his final entry (3:37): "...the son of Adam, the son of God?"
- 3 Jesus is described as "full of the Holy Spirit" and "led by the Spirit" in 4:1. How is this relevant to our understanding of Jesus and understanding the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives?
- 4 Before Jesus' temptation, Luke emphasized the physical weakness of Jesus (4:2). How does this contribute to our understanding of Jesus' humanity?
- 5 What stands out to you about the ways in which the Devil tempted Jesus? Review what the Devil was appealing to in each temptation. (See James 1:13–15.)
- 6 Jesus resisted temptation and refuted the Devil's distortions by quoting Scripture. What does this teach us about how to face temptation? How might you learn to overcome temptation more successfully?
- 7 Jesus was fully human and in a position of weakness, yet He resisted temptation. What does this tell us about the capacity of a believer to resist temptation? (See 1 Corinthians 10:13.)

PRAY

Read Hebrews 2:17,18 and 4:14–16, and consider what Jesus offers believers in the face of temptation. Identify a specific temptation you are facing and ask God to help you embrace Jesus' example and power.
