EXPLORE

- 1 Describe the most serious health issue that you or someone close to you has experienced. What are some words that best portray how you felt during that time?
- 2 Why did the leper ask if Jesus was willing to make him clean? What is significant about human touch, especially toward people in need (5:13)?
- 3 Jesus was a cultural rock star (5:15). Who is the most famous person you have ever met or wanted to meet? Why? What were you hoping to experience or gain?
- 4 What actions of the paralyzed man, and especially his friends, demonstrated faith (5:18–20)? List as many as possible.
- 5 The Pharisees' objections were full of mixed motives (5:21). Name the good and the bad ones. What does this tell us about human nature?
- 6 Jesus could see through people (5:22). What does that say about how God views us?
- 7 Luke piles up positive descriptions of the crowd's response (5:26). Does "everyone" mean everyone? Explain. Why does Luke include these two stories in his Gospel? What do they tell us about Jesus?
