#### **EXPLORE**

- 1 Have you ever been around a person that everyone was drawn to? What made that person so desirable or magnetic? What is the atmosphere around such a person?
- 2 People are very in touch with their physical and psychological needs. Why did that make Jesus such a hero to others (6:17–19)? Is that still true today?
- 3 Jesus pronounces blessing on those who are "poor, hungry, mourning, and hated." Why would this have seemed incomprehensible to His original hearers?
- 4 Jesus pronounces warning on those who are "rich, well fed, laughing, and respected." Why does this seem like a threat to many of us?
- 5 Does Jesus want His followers to display a different perspective in life (mindset) or a different practice in life (conduct)? Explain.
- 6 When we experience exclusion, insults, and rejection, how do we know if that is because of our faith (connection to Jesus) or due to other factors (6:22)?
- 7 Repeatedly the Bible teaches that joy can and should transcend our circumstances and that we are not captive to our present experience (6:23). How is that possible? Is that your experience?
