EXPLORE

- 1 We are called to love our neighbor, which seems doable. We are glad to love our friends, which seems easy (6:32–34). Why?
- 2 Jesus calls us to love our enemies, which is hard. Who are our enemies? Who are your enemies? (Hint: Who hates you, curses you, mistreats you, even from far away?)
- 3 Is Jesus speaking in hyperbole and exaggeration in Luke 6:29,30? Or does He mean what He says? How do you explain those applications in a way that Jesus himself would agree with?
- 4 Read John 15:18–21. How should followers of Jesus expect to be viewed and treated by those who don't follow Him? Does Jesus expect us to be doormats, to experience mistreatment, to endure abuse? Why or why not?
- 5 What is the reward of which Jesus speaks for those who live by the King's Code (6:35)? Why is the King's Code revolutionary, and is it possible in your life in today's world? How?
- 6 "Like Father, like son." How does this phrase highlight the otherworldly nature of the King's Code (6:35,36; Matthew 5:48)?
- 7 If you could summarize the point of 6:37,38, what would it be? (See 6:36).
