#### EXPLORE

- 1 Read Luke 6:43–49. What insights from the sermon and the passage resonate with you?
- 2 How can we accurately assess the state of our heart before the Lord (6:43,44) and avoid the pitfalls of unfounded comfort or unwarranted despair? Why is that so difficult?
- 3 What is the relationship between our heart and our words/actions (6:45)? Why is this significant?
- 4 Why is it important to be concerned with the root (source) of our behavior as well as the fruit? What does the fruit of your life indicate about your heart? Where is growth needed?
- 5 What characterizes the lives of the two different builders (6:46–49)? Given that believers still battle with sin, how do we discern if we are in the category of wise builders who hear Jesus' words and put them into practice?
- 6 We are saved by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8,9). How is this compatible with Jesus' warning to those who do not obey His commandments?
- 7 In what areas of your life have you found obedience to be a joy? Where do you find obedience to be a struggle?

Grant God access to every area of your heart for Him to work as He pleases. Ask God to help you grow in faithful, joyful obedience.
