EXPLORE

- 1 Recall a situation in which you distinctly felt like a second-class participant or an outsider in a group? What thoughts and feelings accompanied that experience?
- 2 In its broadest usage, conversion means a complete change of thinking and direction. Can you identify several times in life where you had a conversion of thinking and direction? Consider beliefs, attitudes, relationships, etc.
- 3 Like many, Peter was deeply steeped in his Jewish identity to the point that he could hardly perceive the heart and plan of God for Gentiles. What unhelpful or negative categorization(s) of people are you most tempted by, whether spiritually or socially?
- 4 Cornelius, like many people in Acts, was prepared by God to hear the Gospel. Yet in our day, we often assume that most people are hostile to the Gospel. Why?
- 5 Reread Acts 10:36–43. What strikes you about Peter's summary of the Gospel of Jesus?
- 6 Take an opportunity to summarize the Gospel in your own words within two minutes. Then ask for feedback on what you can say more clearly or to what you can give greater emphasis.
- 7 Read 2 Corinthians 5:14–16. Consider the phrase, "the ground is even at the foot of the cross." How does faith in Christ convert not only our souls, but also our eyes in how we view others?

PRAY

Ask God to help you see those around you with His perspective.
