- 4 Paul says that God moves so that people would "seek Him and perhaps reach out for Him" (17:27). What does Paul mean here? Are there people who seek for and reach out to God? Explain.
- 5 "Jesus is resurrected. Judgment is coming." Why does this provoke a response then (17:31) and now?
- 6 What details or topics are you surprised that Paul emphasized or omitted in his Gospel summary (17:24–31)? What is fascinating to you about the diverse response to Paul's Gospel summary (17:32–34)?
- 7 What pattern do you see in Paul's preparation and presentation that you desire to adopt in your own witness to the Gospel?
