- 6 God's salvation in the course of history is "to the praise of His glory." Our salvation is central to His plan. How does that liberate and highlight us?
- 7 People who are overwhelmed with wonder and gratitude cannot be mute. They rave about what they have experienced. Is that true of you? Explain your answer.
