- 5 What does Paul want to communicate about the nature of God's power in us when he connects it to the power that raised Jesus from the dead? (1:19b,20)
- 6 How does the picture of Jesus as merely an example of moral living fall woefully short when we see the picture of Jesus in Ephesians 1:20–23?
- 7 What does the present status of Jesus communicate about the present and future status of God's people, the Church? What does this communicate about our importance? (1:20–23)
