- 1 Describe a home project that you have attempted. What's the difference between an adjustment and an overhaul? Which better describes what is needed for humanity in light of Ephesians 2:1-3?
- 2 What's the difference between dead, comatose, ailing, and sick? According to Ephesians 2:1, which is true of humans?
- "The depravity of man is at once the most empirically verifiable reality but at the same time the most intellectually resisted 3 fact" (Malcolm Muggeridge). Do you agree? Why or why not?
- Many verses in the New Testament speak of the resurrecting work of God in sinful human beings. But Paul also highlights 4 the reality that believers are "raised ... and seated" with Christ (2:6). Why is that significant?
- 5 How is salvation by grace such a wondrous gift and a humiliating reality at the same time? Why is this gift so difficult for people to accept? Is (was) it for you?
- The Bible declares salvation is by God's grace alone. It is not our works that earn anything. What are indications that 6 someone, even a professing believer, is trying to earn salvation?
- 7 We are not only saved from our sins and past selves, we are saved to a life of good works (2:10). How does that give our present lives purpose and significance?
