- 2 Do you find Paul's prayer for power inviting, exciting, or intimidating (or choose another word to describe it)? Explain what makes you receive his prayer in this way.
- 3 How can a passage like this (Ephesians 3:14–21) encourage us and instruct us when we face situations in which we don't know how or even what to pray?
- 4 How might the Church function differently if we embraced and realized the power Paul prays about more fully? How might our church? How might you?
- 5 How have you experienced the Spirit's power renovating your heart as a dwelling fit for Christ?
- 6 If a sin struggle has slowed down the renovation progress in your heart, how is that connected to failing to grasp God's love for you or failing to experience power together through the church?
- 7 Which aspect of Christ's love thrills you the most today (wide, long, high, or deep)?
