- 1 Have you ever had someone speak directly and candidly into your life? Did you listen to them and respect what they said? Why or why not?
- 2 Paul speaks of the "futility" of the Gentiles' way of thinking, meaning purposelessness, aimlessness, meaninglessness (4:17). What evidence for that do you see in our society?
- 3 We prove what we believe and value by the conduct of our lives. How does Ephesians 4:18,19 show that?
- 4 Condescending people say: "How awful they are!" Humble people say: "But for the grace of God, there go I." How do we grow in our humility?
- 5 The ongoing imperative (command) in Ephesians 4:22–24 is "to be made new (renewed) in the attitude of our minds." Compare with Romans 12:2. What does this renewal involve?
- 6 Does our sanctification (maturing in holy living) depend upon our effort or God's work? Explain your answer from this passage.
- 7 What is the goal and destiny of believers (4:24)? Why is knowledge of the goal so important?

Pray that your heart would be humble and sensitive to the Lord in order to recognize and pursue what is true of you. (Ephesians 4:24).
