EXPLORE

- 1 Faith in Jesus means coming to Jesus to have your soul's hunger and thirst satisfied in Him. What does this truly mean and what does it look like? How can we verbalize this aspect of faith when we share the Gospel?
- 2 Read John 6:39,40. If we believe in Jesus, this is meant to place assurance in our hearts concerning our final destiny. Is your faith anchored in the finished work of Jesus? Do you have confidence in your own resurrection because of His resurrection? Explain your response.
- 3 Are there areas of Scripture at which you take offense or have a hard time understanding as these listeners did in Jesus' time? If so, what are they? Knowing that all Scripture is breathed out by God, how can we ensure that we are submitting ourselves to all that the Bible says?
- 4 Jesus has the words of eternal life (John 6:68,69) which means we should immerse ourselves in them. What does it mean to be immersed in Scripture? What are the results? What are ways we can be immersing ourselves in Scripture on a regular basis as an individual? As a family? As a church?
- 5 Many of Jesus' disciples turned back (John 6:66). What are concrete ways that we can encourage each other to endure in sound doctrine and Christian living? What are some of God's promises to which we can cling to help us endure?
