EXPLORE

- 1 What idea or point of application resonated with you from the sermon?

- 3 In verses 4–9, Samuel experienced God’s calling. What does it look like for us to be attentive to God’s voice and His calling?
- 4 Like Samuel did with Eli, why is it important to consult with other wise believers when we are trying to discern God’s Word? Is there something you feel God is currently calling you to do in your life that would benefit from discussion with other believers?
- 5 Why could verse 14 never be said of us? What would it take for that truth to make our ears tingle, as verse 11 states?
- 6 Verse 21 equates the revelation of God Himself with the revelation of His Word. Why is this true? What does this teach us about God’s Word?

PRAY

Pray that the Lord would always help you discern His voice, both the voice you hear from His Word and from the Spirit’s day-to-day leading in your life.
