#### **HIGHLIGHT STORY**

When Rebecca shops at her local grocery store, she chooses to check out with different cashiers that she has previously interacted with to follow up with them. One day she asked a cashier how he was doing, and he shared that he was anxious. Rebecca asked how she could be praying for him, and he shared a specific request with her. After checking out, she wrote him a note including Philippians 4:6–7 and handed it to him on her way out as an encouragement.

#### **CHALK TALK**

Last week, Florent Varak shared about planting, sowing and reaping. The Bible uses this language often, including Jesus when He shares the parable of the sower in Matthew 13. This week we want to consider the soil of a person's heart and how we can use listening, seeing, and wondering to potentially gauge where they are. We also provide helpful advice on how to approach people. Hopefully it will inspire you to think of other ways as well.
