The Passover Plan

PASTOR MIKE YODER • EXODUS 11-12

With God on Our Side

An Exploration of Exodus

The Ultimatum: The Lord confronts Pharaoh through Moses. (11:1-10)

The Commemoration: The Lord outlines His ordinance for the Israelites. (12:1-20)

The Directive: Moses calls the Israelites to obey God's saving prescription. (12:21-28)

The Consequence: The Lord metes out judgment through the plague. (12:29,30)

God's plan to deliver His people is *trust and obey.*

DIG DEEPER

God used ten plagues against Pharaoh before liberating the Israelites. Why did God use so many if just one or several would have been sufficient?

Why do you think Moses was "hot with anger" after speaking with Pharaoh (11:8)? When is it appropriate to be angry? What guidelines should God's people observe in expressing anger?

At least three times (12:14, 17, 24), the Passover is described as a "lasting ordinance." Why was God so insistent that it couldn't fade away? If communion is Jesus' "lasting ordinance" for us (1 Corinthians 11:20-26), why shouldn't it fade away in our commitment and practice?
