You Have the Words of Eternal Life

DR. JEREMY KIMBLE
JOHN 6:22-71

Don't look for mere temporary pleasure. Labor for food that leads to eternal life. (6:22-27)

Do the work of God. Believe in Jesus. (6:28,29)

Partake of true bread. Let your soul be satisfied with Jesus. (6:30-40)

Don't grumble. Eat the flesh and drink the blood of the Son of Man. (6:41-59)

Don't be offended. Only Jesus has the words of eternal life. (6:60-71)

Look to Jesus with soul-satisfying faith and treasure His Word.

DIG DEEPER

Faith in Jesus means coming to Jesus to have your soul's hunger and thirst satisfied in Him. What does this truly mean and what does it look like? How can we verbalize this aspect of faith when we share the Gospel?

Jesus has the words of eternal life (John 6:68,69) which means we should immerse ourselves in them. What does it mean to be immersed in Scripture? What are the results? What are ways we can be immersing ourselves in Scripture on a regular basis as an individual? As a family? As a church?

Many of Jesus' disciples turned back (John 6:66). What are concrete ways that we can encourage each other to endure in sound doctrine and Christian living? What are some of God's promises to which we can cling to help us endure?
