PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over the past few weeks you have been encouraged to think about what type of soil best represents the heart of the person to whom you are seeking to witness (Matthew 13:1–9, 18–23). - 6 How do you sense the Lord leading you to apply the teaching from 1 Samuel?
