Philippians 2:5

who, though He was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,

Philippians 2:6

*but emptied Himself, by taking the form of a servant,
being born in the likeness of men.*

And being found in human form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Therefore God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the Name that is above every name,
