Ministry Internship Program

Overview

The Ministry Internship Program at Grace Polaris Church seeks to develop and invest in potential ministry leaders who display godly character, giftedness, and interest in local church leadership. This is done by providing structured ministry opportunities and intentional personal investment for the intern.

Description

The Ministry Internship Program program lasts approximately ten weeks (from early- to mid-May through early August) and is available to men and women enrolled in college or seminary. The goal of the program is to assist men and women in their preparation for ministry in a local church setting. It is not meant to be a comprehensive assessment of the participants' gifts and abilities, but rather is designed to introduce them to the life of local church ministry.

A Typical Week

The intern will split his or her time between ministry observation (such as ministry leader meetings), assistance (such as planning and administration), participation (such as small groups and teaching), and reflection (such as intern investment meeting, reading, and writing). Interns will be responsible for various reading and writing assignments, small group discussion and reflection, as well as teaching and leading opportunities.

The intern will be expected to attend staff meetings, elder's meetings, pastoral meetings, all public services, staff prayer times, intern investment meetings, weekly service reviews, weddings, wedding rehearsals, funerals, and any miscellaneous meetings that arise throughout the week. The intern is expected to schedule individual lunches with at least three church elders and each member of the pastoral staff. The intern should also schedule individual lunches with three people who have been at the church for more than ten years and three people who have been at the church less than ten years. These meetings provide deeper insight into the history of the local church and the lives of the church's leaders.

- Weekly reports: written reports that allow the intern to put forth questions and personal responses to what God is teaching them and what they are learning during the program
