Pastoral Residency Program

Overview

The Pastoral Residency Program at Grace Polaris Church seeks to equip young leaders for faithful, long-term ministry in order to train the next generation of pastors, church planters, and church leaders. The goal is that residents would be changed by the Gospel and taught to lead out of that change while learning and practicing effective tools for ministry.

Description

The Pastoral Residency Program program is a two-year commitment with assessments every three months. Commitments from both the resident and Grace Polaris Church are for 12 months at a time. The residnecy is designed for men who sense and have some affirmation of God's calling to leadership in the local church as either a pastor, church planting pastor, or elder. The qualifications would be that fitting of an elder in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1.

Philosophy & Approach

The program will have a fourfold approach:

Cultivation A primary goal is that a resident would fall more in love with Jesus and his church. Too many ministers fail because they were not truly gripped and changed by the Gospel.

Training After the program our hope is that most residents will be sent either into local church ministry or church planting. Residents will read selected material, complete assignments, and receive mentoring to develop skills and acquire knowledge for long term ministry.

Observation Virtually every aspect of the church will be for available observation and participation. Residents will be expected to attend ministry, elder, leader, and pastoral meetings. Being a fly on the wall in counseling, sermon prep, and planning meetings will help a resident gain experience in important features of local church ministry.

Responsibility The resident will be given responsibility and oversight of ministries at Grace Polaris which will require his oversight and support.

A Typical Week

The resident will be fully engaged with the life of ministry and the church. The resident is expected to become a member of Grace Polaris Church and engage in ways expected of all members, including all corporate gatherings. The resident will also attend and participate in all staff meetings, including ministry and shepherding teams. He will be asked to assist in teaching, funerals, weddings, communions, and other ministries of the church, as well as lead various groups, Bible studies, and ministry initiatives. He will disciple others as well as meet with various members of the church and most of the elders throughout his time at Grace Polaris Church. On occasion, the resident may be asked to provide pulpit or teaching supply at another church if the opportunity arises.

The general work week will be Monday–Thursday from 9:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m., Fridays from 9:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m., various evening ministries, and Sunday services and gatherings (35–40 hours a week).

Report

Residents will report directly to the assistant pastor. Residents will work alongside, assist, and support other pastoral and ministry staff.

Other pastoral staff will include residents in various ministry opportunities, tasks, or responsibilities. This will help residents to have a well-rounded experience while also having their own responsibilities. Monthly ministry reports will be completed and reviewed by supervisors.
