*O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified.*

Galatians 3:1

*Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?*

Galatians 3:2

*Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?*

Galatians 3:3

*Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain?*

Galatians 3:4

*Does He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—*

Galatians 3:5

*just as Abraham “believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness”?*

Galatians 3:6



*Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham.*

Galatians 3:7

*And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the Gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed."*

Galatians 3:8

*So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.*

Galatians 3:9

*For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, “Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them.”*

Galatians 3:10

*Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for “The righteous shall live by faith.”*

Galatians 3:11

*But the law is not of faith, rather “The one who does them shall live by them.”*

Galatians 3:12

*Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree”—*

Galatians 3:13

*so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.*

Galatians 3:14




Don't be stupid: we receive
